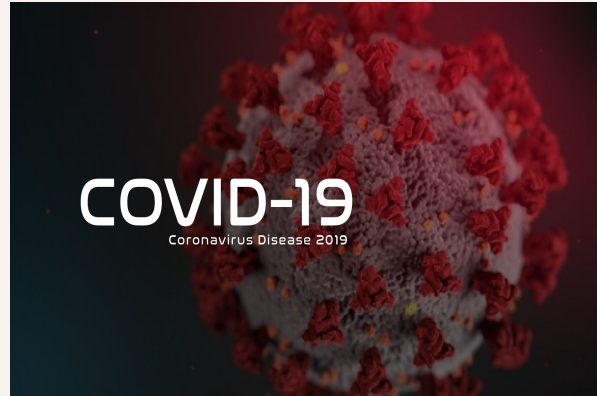

BEFORE (2018)

- Jp: About 54.8%
- Vn: About 28.54%



DURING (12.2019 - NOW)

- Jp: About 54.8%
- Vn: About 28.64%

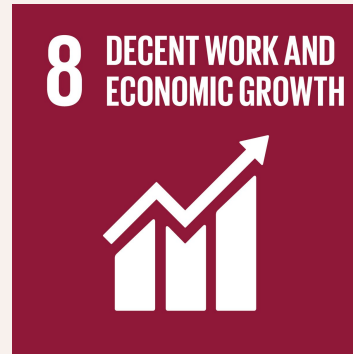
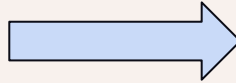

THE IMPACT OF EDUCATION ON STUDENTS AND ECONOMIC GROWTH

- More productive as the proportion of educated workers



DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HIGH SCHOOL GRAD. AND UNIVERSITY GRAD.

1 yen = 208.95 VND

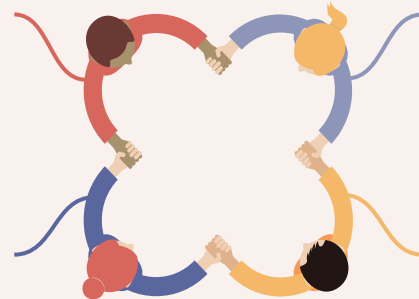
- Japan:
 - The average of salaries: High School => 260,000 yen
: University => 369,000 yen
 - The average of life-time earning
High School => 210,000,000 yen
University => 260,000,000 yen



DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HIGH SCHOOL GRAD. AND UNIVERSITY GRAD.

1 yen = 208.95 VND

- Vietnam:
 - For HRM: 5.000.000 - 7.000.000 VND/ month
 - For Banking industry: 21.000.000 - 31.000.000 VND/ month

- Starting from a small group such as NPO (Non-Profit Organization) organized by university students



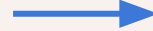

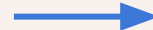
Pros and cons

Advantage

1. Increasing the number of students in university
2. The implementation by younger generations is more stable, sustainable, and realistic



Attract the attention of volunteers or some sponsors



Encourage younger generation to go to university

Pros and cons

Disadvantage

1. Hard to collect organizers and organize at first
2. Need to find fees for operation and maintain the program
3. Have to negotiate with the people who are working at universities without the support from experts

3. Return the money from their salary

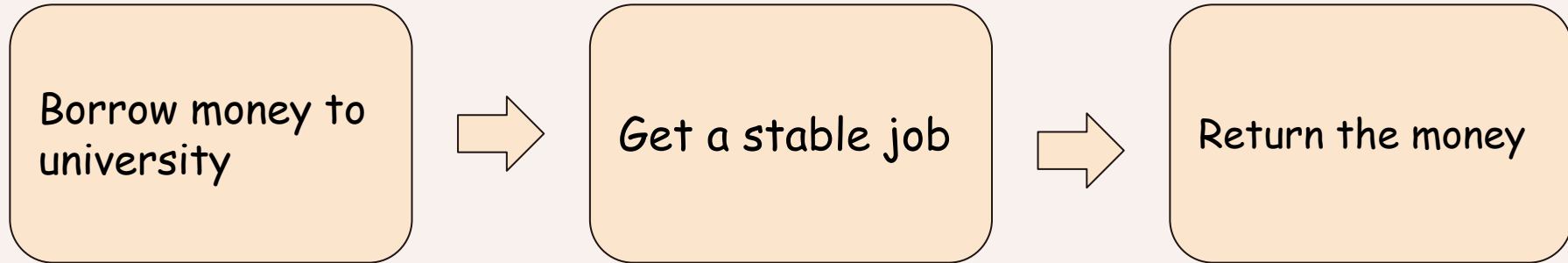
The benefits:

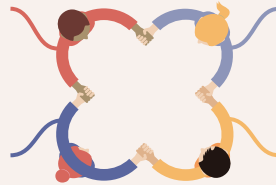

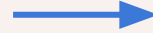

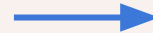
Pros and cons

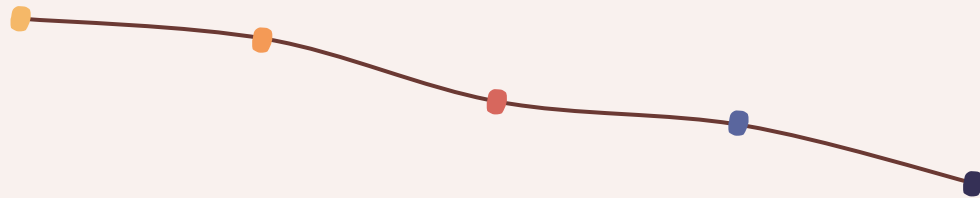
